## 2005 Grants Awarded

The Grant Distribution Committee was pleased to award grants to the following organizations at the recent Founders Community Celebration. 2005 committee members were Co-Chairmen Bob Sowinski and Dave Putz, and Judy Dannes, Bill McPartlon, and Mike Mullaney. NCF received 33 grant inquiries seeking over \$100,000 this year alone.

- Association for the Protection of the Adirondacks
- **\$3,800** for computers and video equipment for historic preservation.
- **Bellevue Hospital \$897** to assist with 9-week educational program.
- **Birchwood PTO \$1,030** to purchase and install Adaptive Swing Set for handicapped children.
- **High School PTO \$2,100** for display case to recognize and encourage academic achievements.
- JCC \$3,000 for early childhood playground facilitating outdoor activity and exercise for increasing numbers of young daycare and after school children.
- Niskayuna Day Care \$2,000 for equipment and to assist with ongoing needs for expansion and improvement of needed facility.
- Niskayuna Drama Club \$1,000 toward the purchase of a light system at the Little Theater.
- Niskayuna English Dept \$1,500 to support "writer-in-residency" program.
- Niskayuna Lacrosse Club Inc. \$3,000 to assist with safe equipment needs for expanding community based program.
- Town of Niskayuna Recreation Department -\$1,000 - for handicapped equipment for Town pool.

In addition, Mini-grants were distributed earlier this year to:

- Class of 2006 \$600 to fund a safe, healthy alternative for the junior class post prom celebration.
- **Proctors Theatre \$1,000** to fund a dance residency program at Rosendale School.
- Van Antwerp \$400 to underwrite a program for Niskayuna youth to help the Double "H" Hole in the Woods Camp. Under teacher Mr. Pletman at Van Antwerp Middle School, students learned the value of helping others through this project which helped to make the environment nicer for children facing critical illnesses.

## 2006 Grants Funds Announced...

The Board of Directors has allocated \$20,000 for grants and mini-grants in 2006.

To be eligible, the applicant organization must qualify under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code as a non-profit organization, operate under the fiscal sponsorship of an organization that does, or be sponsored by either the Niskayuna Town or the Niskayuna School District. NCF places the highest priority on projects that address significant community issues. Grants may be awarded in; health and human services, arts and culture, community development, conservation and historic preservation, and recreation. Grants may also be made for capital projects including equipment purchases.

Single grants will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000. A letter of inquiry is initially required by March 1, 2006. It should not exceed two pages, and should include: introduction to organization's mission, recent achievements, problems or opportunities to be addressed, specifics about the grant, and total costs. Eligible organizations will be invited to submit a final application in April. Mini-grants up to \$1000 may be applied for throughout the year.
